The residency is an opportunity for Wac Arts to introduce external talent into the building which will benefit our students and town hall where Wac Arts is based. Ideally we'd like for artists to engage with Wac Arts programs in a practical way by offering their expertise through either teaching/workshops/talks, coordinating a project or enabling students to see the work you've been producing. We understand that it is not always possible for artists to donate time in this way so if your project does not include this collaborative element, please ensure you describe how your time with us will provide tangible benefits to our organisation, this could be through a fraction of ticket/artwork sales made to the charity.

In return Wac Arts can offer over the course of the three month residency; access to free rehearsal space for performative projects, to audio visual equipment, to collaborative opportunities with our current programs, exhibition space in our Atrium, promotion through our social media to and mailing list.

Prospective AIR are required to provide a statement (no more than 500 words) outlining your practice and areas of interest, an indication of how you wish to use this opportunity and which Wac Arts program you wish to collaborate with, plus CV (no more than 2 sides of A4)
