JOB SUMMARY

This role facilitates transportation between various residential addresses in the borough of Camden and our building in Belsize Park.

Sessions where transport is required occur on Thursday evenings after school in term time and Saturdays in term time over thirty-nine weeks of the year. Sessions also take place during school holidays (half term holidays, Easter & Summer holidays) for nine weeks of the year and run from Monday to Friday.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

The following sets out the key responsibilities and is not intended as an exhaustive list. The role will require other duties relevant to providing a high-quality service.

- Safely transport our young people to and from the building
- Arrive in sufficient time to undertake the pre route vehicle checks and required paperwork
- Ensure risk assessments/ registers and any other relevant paperwork is completed for your activity and returned promptly to your line manager
- Take responsibility for following Health and Safety regulations and procedures
- Plan routes for pick-ups and ensure a timely delivery to building.
- Wait on the Wac Arts premises during the sessions in the event that home journeys need to be undertaken early.
- Act as the face of Wac Arts for participants, parents & guardians
- Act professionally and with enthusiasm for Wac Arts activity, at all times

- Adhere to the Highway Code and comply with all traffic regulations
- Adhere to the Wac Arts Policy on reporting and responding to an accident
- Report and record any issues surrounding safeguarding according to the Wac Arts Safeguarding Policy
- To feed back any important/relevant information regarding the vehicle to your line manager
- Adhere to all Wac Arts policies
- Attend programme meetings and training as requested by your line manager
- Other duties which may from time to time be required by your line manager
